# Centerpiece

**H**igh above the Las Vegas Strip – 600 feet above, as a matter of fact – three new venues can be found atop the Palms Fantasy Tower.

Your first stop is on the 51st floor at the Nove restaurant, with a high-tech atmosphere and food supervised by consulting chef Michael Kornic of Chicago's acclaimed mk restaurant.

A short ride up on an escalator takes you to the 52nd floor and the Playboy Club, the first one built in the past 20 years, where you can lounge, gamble

and ogle (not necessarily in that order). It was designed by Chicago's 555 International design group.

The colors and textures are masculine in tone; video screens highlight Playboy images and a wall clad in red crocodile leather embraces a 10-foot long linear gas fireplace.

Hop on another gorgeous escalator and you're now on the 53rd floor and in the Moon nightclub, with spacious, built-in leather seating, a retractable roof, and what has to be the absolutely best

view of Las Vegas and the night sky available. This is a rooftop Paradise.

Nevertheless, perhaps because this is a hearth, patio and barbecue magazine, we're still most impressed by that beautiful gas fireplace, the centerpiece of the room, which wrested that distinction from rather formidable, and scantily clad, competition.
